- Timings** 09:00 Registration opens both days
09:15 Assembly
09:30 Up to 45 minutes practice on the tournament field under control of the Judges. Equipment inspection will be done during practice.
- Round:** **Day 1** - 10.15 Fita and Metrics - two details 4 archers per boss*.
(Individual faces for sighted archers at 50m and 30m)
Day 2 - 10:15 FITA 70 m ranking round (Cadet 60m) - two details 4 archers per boss*.
On completion of the FITA 70m ranking round (approximately 13.00), there will be a short break whilst archers are seeded for the Olympic round Head to Head element. This will be the only planned break on each day. Official practice for the afternoon session will be taken during this time. All archers will go into the head to head; higher placed archers will receive a bye in the earliest round.
The programme for the Olympic round will be published on the day. In all matches up to and including the Quarter-finals the archers will shoot simultaneously, the best of three, six arrow sets. In the semi-finals and finals, archers will alternate under the control of a match judge, the best of five, three arrow sets

- Dress** GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain dark green / white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Archers are requested to observe the dress regulations until after the presentations
- Drug Testing:** Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
- Smoking:** This is a non smoking event. If you have to partake, please retire well behind the tented area.
- Photography:** In view of the provisions of the GNAS Policy for Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.
- GNAS/IAAA Cards:** Archers should have their GNAS or IAAA membership cards available
- Lost arrows:** All lost arrows **MUST** be reported to a judge or member of the field party. (Please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the responsibility of the archer to make sure that all arrows are accounted for before leaving the field.



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Awards:

Medals will be awarded to the archers placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category at the end of day 1 & day 2 subject to the number of entries

Target lists

Target lists and results will be published on the City of Belfast website.

Entry fee:

Seniors Both days £20.00, Single day £12.00 (£15.00 and £10.00 if paid in advance)
Juniors Both days £12.00, Single day £7.00. (£10.00 and £5.00 if paid in advance)

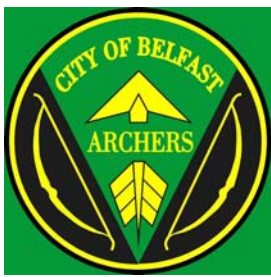
